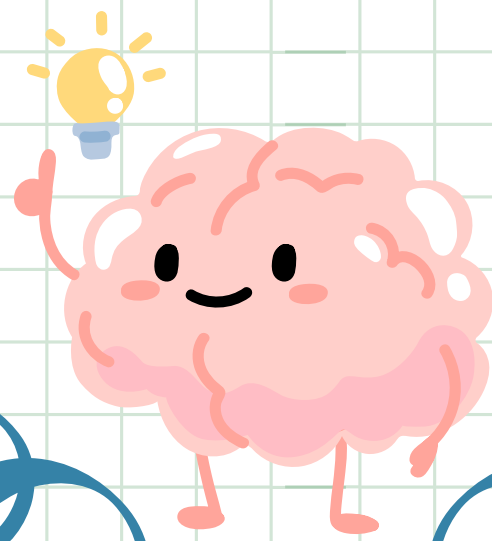


## Writing

# Year 4 Summer 1

## RE

**Religion:** Christianity

**Key Question:** For Christians, when Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?

## Science

Within Science we will be learning about 'Teeth and Eating.'

We will be exploring the functions of different types of teeth and the anatomy of the tooth, and how teeth are involved within our digestive system topic.

## Geography

We will be focussing on reading a range of different types of maps such as ordnance maps, tube maps and cycle maps. We will also learn about longitude and latitude and how to read this in an atlas.

## PSHE

This half term, our topic is 'Healthy Living'. We will be focusing on the importance of a healthy body and mind and ways we can achieve this.

## Art

**Artist Focus:** Andy Warhol  
We will be practicing colour mixing, sketching and painting to create our very own pop art pieces focusing on mouths and teeth.

## Computing

Children will build their understanding of how digital images can be edited and enhanced. They will explore using filters and editing tools, as well as learning how to save and reuse their work. Pupils will discuss how editing images can change their meaning and will begin to think about the ethical considerations involved in altering photographs.

## Music

We start by developing our Ukulele skills, playing the simple chords gently to avoid sore fingers. We shall then explore the art of Foley and Mickey mousing. We will need to choose the correct items to make the perfect sound with great timing and teamwork, requiring concentration and creativity. Some of the year 4's will be performing at the Eisteddfod and potentially at Government House. More details to follow.

## PE

This half term we will continue to develop a range of object control skills, including: throwing, catching, kicking and dribbling. We will also continue to apply skills in modified versions of games such as 'Floorball'.
