## Mathematics

We will be learning...

- Fractions (including half and and quarter)
- Numbers to 100
  - Time
  - Money

## Science

This half term in science, we will be learning about the seasons. We will explore how the weather changes throughout the year. We will look at the different types of clothing we wear in each season and discuss why they are suitable for the weather. We will also learn about hibernation and how some animals rest during the colder months to save energy when food is limited. In addition, we will investigate how daylight hours change in different seasons, noticing how days are longer in summer and shorter in winter.

## English:

Reading sessions- Children will continue to focus on comprehension and will work on their prediction skills. We will also be looking at different poems throughout the term.

Key Writing Skills to be covered this half term:

- Sequencing a short story
- Writing a list



## P.E


This half term we will continue to develop a range of fundamental movement skills such as: running, jumping, skipping, throwing, catching, kicking and dribbling. We will also be looking to apply these skills in a number of different exciting games.



## Art and DT

In Art this half term the children will discuss and create their own silhouette art inspired by Nikolai Tolstoy. In D.T this half term the children will be making their own animal puppet, practicing the skill of sewing.

## Geography




The children will be creating their own maps. They will learn how to include a compass to show direction and a key. We will explore how maps can be drawn from different viewpoints. This will include looking at bird's-eye view maps, where places are shown from above.



## Music

In music we shall be having a go at playing the Ukulele and learning how to strum gently so we don't hurt our fingers. We will then move onto making sound effects ( Foley) for a short cartoon. This involves good choices, timing and team work. Finally we explore digital music such as Chrome music and explore what can be created.

## RE



This half term, we will be learning about the creation of the world, focusing on what Christians believe God created over seven days. We will explore the qualities of creators and what it means to create. As part of our learning, we will recite the poem "God Made the Sun" and perform it with actions to support expression and understanding.

## Computing

We will continue exploring early programming concepts, with a focus on using individual commands with Bee-Bots. Learners will build on their understanding by applying simple sequences of instructions. They will put their skills into practice by attempting to follow a set path, using the Bee-Bot command buttons accurately and in the correct order.
